AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SKY TAVERN JUNIOR SKI PROGRAM

ARTICLE I Name and Type of Corporation

The name of the corporation is Sky Tavern Junior Ski Program (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II
Duration

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

Purposes

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation, organized solely for general charitable purposes or for a combination of educational, scientific, and charitable purposes. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Corporation may engage in any lawful activity, including without limitation: (1) promotion of youth snow sports; (2) planning, training and provision recreational activities for the citizens of the Truckee Meadows with special emphasis on the training of children in the proper methods of mountain recreation, regardless of physical or financial limitations; (3) enabling all in the Truckee Meadows to enjoy the benefits of Sky Tavern Park; (3) enhancing, developing and caring for the Sky Tavern Park for use to the general community on a year round basis.; and (4) further developing the Sky Tavern Park to include special events and meeting places; so long as such activity does not impair the Corporation's status as a charitable or educational organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV Directors

The Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors which shall consist of not less than five (5) directors. The number of directors of the Corporation may be increased or decreased from time to time in such a manner as shall be provided by the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V Amendment These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation may be amended by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Directors entitled to vote on each such amendment.

ARTICLE VII Liability

Directors and officers of the Corporation shall be indemnified by the Corporation from any expenses, costs, damages or otherwise to the maximum extent permitted by the Nevada Revised Statutes in NRS 82.221.
